
The Fingerprinting and the Criminal History Record Check <u>require two separate online applications</u> before a student can begin their field experiences. Every student must have fingerprints taken at a <u>Maine approved</u> fingerprint site. A Criminal History Record Check approval from the Department of Education, which is based on the fingerprint results, is <u>also</u> required. Please follow the steps below.

## 1. Create an account on the DOE MEIS database


- Click on the link <u>Create a MEIS account</u> to create your DOE online account. This will be used in the future for certification purposes, as well.
- b) <u>How to Submit Your CHRC Application</u> there is a \$15 fee for this process. Once your account is created, log in and choose 'Apply for Your New Maine Credential Here.' Click through the demographic pages.



- c) Choose 'No Bachelor Degree.'
- d) When you get to the 'Add New Credentials' page, click on the Add Credentials to Cart button



You will see a PopUp called Endorsement Selection. Be sure to choose **Non-Teaching Approval**, the top button.



If the amount in your cart is not \$15, you did not choose the correct credential.

- e) Skip the next three screens by clicking 'Next' at the bottom of the page on Steps 10 (Upload Transcript), 11 (Upload Test Results), and 12 (Upload Additional Documents).
- f) You will then arrive at a screen where you enter your credit card information and finish the application.

## 2. Fingerprinting Process

- a) <u>Visit Identogo</u> <u>https://me.ibtfingerprint.com/</u> to make a fingerprinting appointment. There is a \$55 fee for this process.
- b) Click the green Schedule a New Appointment box
- c) Agency Name: choose **Department of Education** in the dropdown; confirm on next screen
- d) If you live outside the State of Maine, you can choose the Card Scan Processing program. Follow the dropdown for *Out of State Applicants*. Otherwise,
- e) Applicant Type: New Hire
- f) Click to AGREE
- g) Click 'Search by Region,' then 'Maine" to see a choice of all locations in Maine.
- h) Choose your location, date and time. Appointments are offered at UMF on the 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>
  Tuesday of each month, and the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Friday of each month. If you don't see an option to
  Schedule at your chosen location, click on 'Next Week' on the top right to advance the date.
- i) On the Applicant Information page, you **do not** need to fill in the Applicant Employer Information section.
- j) You must register ahead of time, as locations do not accept walk ins.
- k) Take your confirmation (received after registration) and an approved form of ID to the fingerprint site on the assigned date and time. Please note UMF IDs are NOT an acceptable form of identification. It must be a government-issued ID. First year and transfer students entering **ALL** UMF Teacher Education programs (ECH, ECS, ELE, Secondary/Middle, SED, Phys Ed, School Health and WLK-12) **must be fingerprinted and have a Criminal History Record Check prior to their first field experience.** All students **MUST** provide evidence of their Initial Educational Approval to Field Services prior to going into the field.

Once you have completed both steps, you will be waiting for Approval from the Certification Office. The Department of Education (DOE) does not notify you or UMF of your CHRC approval. You must take the following steps to ensure that you can be enrolled in your first practicum.

Here is the process:

- 1. Go to this website: <a href="https://www.maine.gov/doe/cert/status">https://www.maine.gov/doe/cert/status</a>
- 2. Click on "I Do Not Have a MEIS Account" (even though this is not true; that is the only way to the site)
- 3. Type in your last name and the last four numbers of your social security number
- 4. Click 'Submit'
- 5. If you see "No Data Available" or "No Certification Found at this time" below the blue line, you have not received approval yet
- 6. If you have received approval, you will see:

You can also log into your MEIS account and check there, looking for the same information above. **Be sure your** name appears on the evidence along with the approval information.

To meet UMF Eligibility requirements for courses with field placements:

- 1. Print and scan the page; OR
- 2. Save the page as a PDF; OR
- 3. Take a screenshot, being sure to include all of the information on the page
