Campus:

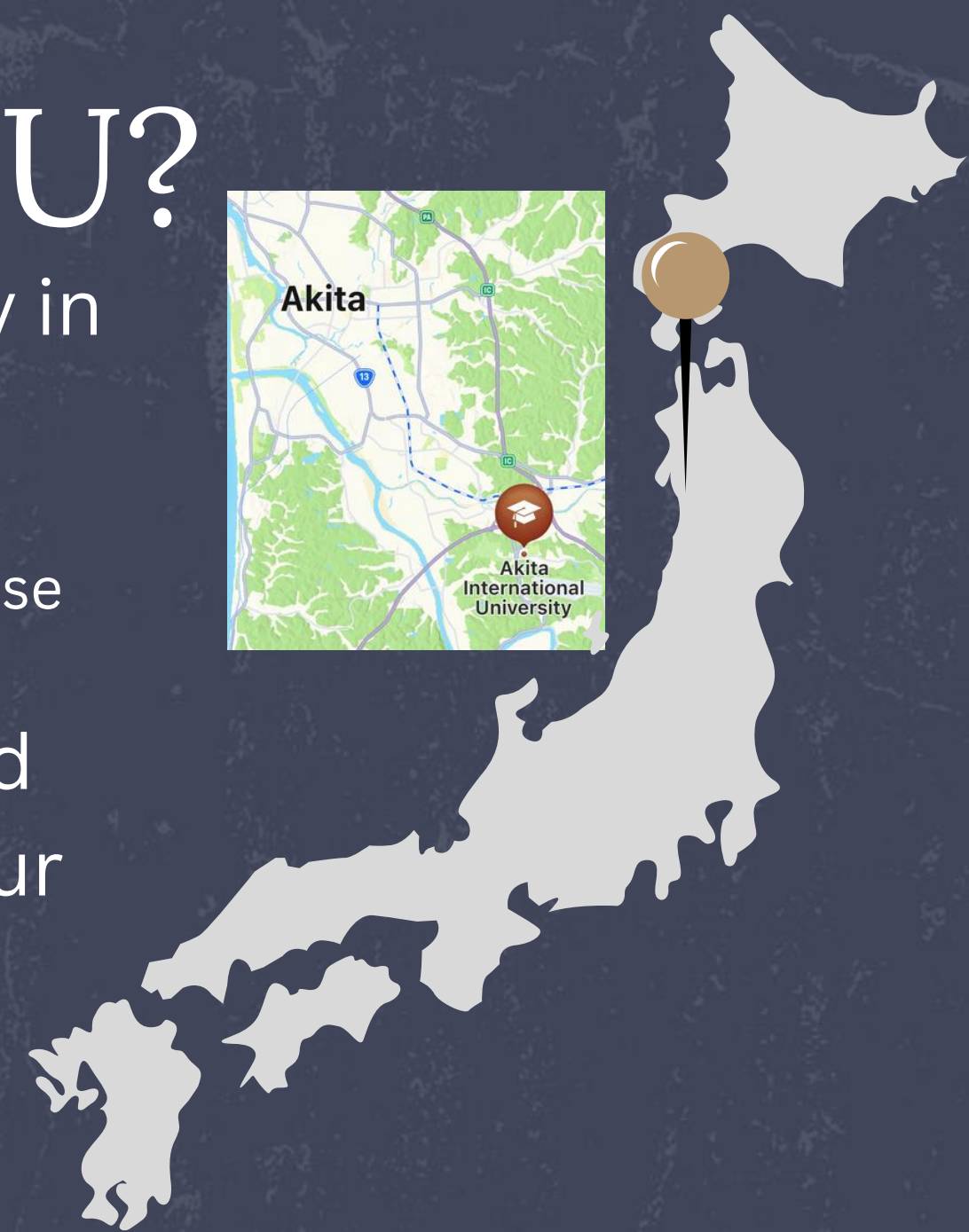
Konbini, Nepali restaurant, local bikes for rent, Olympic sports park, *the library*

Application and Flights

- Through school application
- Consulate (passport and student visa)
 - Apply for flights in advance
- Acceptance but no information
 - International flights

Medical issues

- Health insurance is a must have
- ^ Even without it can be cheap
- If you visit a hospital: you get a patient card - be prepared to fill out form
 - Prepare any necessary medication (non-controlled - double check) beforehand

Passports and IDs

- No need to carry passport
- Student and Resident ID
- Keep health insurance and Resident ID on you at all times

Money, Visas cards, and Suicas

- Can pay tuition with FAFSA
- Pay for your own flights
 - Set money aside for:
 - Meal plan
 - Room & board
 - Health insurance
- American Visa issues

Budgeting

- Transportation
 - Bedding
- Food (if no meal plan: groceries)
 - Textbooks
- Dorm supplies (shared supplies)
 - Vacations
